# Multimodal Subcommittee 2019-08-20 Meeting Notes

Subcommittee Mission: Improve communication between MaineDOT and Consultants and assist MaineDOT in achieving Multimodal Program goals.

Reviewed and accepted June 25, 2019 meeting notes.

Reviewed the draft Section 531 Marine Structures specification that Craig Morin provided and discussed the following:

- Mike noted that Jeff Tweedie and Rich Crawford suggested including this specification section in the repair specification because the deadline for inclusion of a new section in the upcoming revision of the Standard Specifications is too close.
- Mike said that he would ask Aurele Gorneau and Nate Benoit to also review the draft Section 531 specification and provide comments by the next meeting.
- Agreed to not develop the draft Section 531 specification further until MaineDOT review comments are received.
- Subcommittee members agreed to email any additional sample marine project special provisions they can find to Craig prior to the next meeting.
- Mike said that he would ask Aurele Gorneau to provide some additional MaineDOT marine project special provisions as additional samples.

### Other items discussed include:

- Reviewed the suggestions by subcommittee members for improving the delivery of Locally Administered Projects, including the several items summarized in an 8/19/2019 email from subcommittee member Sean Thies. Steven said that he will coordinate with Rob Wright and others at FHWA about national best practices for LAP's and provide any information he finds at the next meeting.
- Mike noted that a set of ADA standard details has just been issued. He will distribute them to all subcommittee members.
