Discussion Items:

- 1. Department Staff Changes
 - Charles Sims, District 8 PM, will be leaving the department.
 - Scott Sundermeyer, OU/ODOT Cultural Resources Program Manager, is leaving the position.
- 2. Funding Updates
 - State budget has been approved as of June 12, 2024.
 - ODOT does not anticipate any funding shortfalls for 2024-2025.
 - Consultants will hopefully see more consistent funding soon. There is no change in outlook on the current funding process/timeline.
- 3. TOPS Pending Project List
 - The department is working on formatting improvements for the published pending project list in TOPS.
 - They are reviewing content as well as documenting the criteria used to determine which projects are included in the list.
 - The current purpose of the list is to detail which projects are intended to be included on solicitations within the next year.
- 4. 8-Year Plan Funding
 - ODOT is considering adding design funding to the 8-Year Funding plan.
 - ODOT is researching the implications of this before implementing.
- 5. Project Initiation Process
 - ODOT is reviewing the project initiation process (prior to solicitations) including data reconnaissance.
 - They would like to get feedback from consultants regarding what is working and what can be improved with the process.

- 6. Alternative Delivery Method
 - A selection has been made for alternative delivery assistance with the Roosevelt Bridge project.





- Grandsberg and Associates was selected to help ODOT develop processes and procedure documents with the intent of soliciting alternative delivery method projects in the future.
- The current contract is not to perform design build work on the Roosevelt bridge but to help establish guidelines for future work on the bridge.
