1. VTrans Construction Management System (CMS) Update: Phil Dessureau

- Phil is with the Agency of Digital Services. This agency is managing the CMS update process.
- Due to needed changes, the process has been rescoped with significant scope, schedule and budget changes.
- Project challenges included vendor experience, contract deficiencies, lack of subject matter experts (SME's), a new team Phil, Molly, and previously oversold expectations
- With new process and scope there is now a positive outlook improved governance, engaged SME's, small work packages, using lessons learned, prioritized as a top project, identified management process, improved vendor relationship.
- Due scope changes deployment schedule has changed as follows: 7/30/2020 eContracting; 9/14/2021 Materials; 9/01/2023 Construction; 6/13/2024 Civil Rights

- The office move from National Life to Barre City Place is mostly completed.






FIRST FLOOR VTRANS Barre City Place | City of Barre, VT
