#### Legislative

Brian provided an update

- The Legislative Committee recently met to discuss the bill tracking process and goals
  of the committee. Meeting attendees included: Brian Beaudoin, Brendan Cosgrove,
  Aaron Guyette, Shawn Kelley, Kathy Nanowski of Fuss & O'Neill, John Wilson of
  Jacobs, and Tom Knight of Stantec.
- The committee discussed the bill tracking process and the possibility of hiring a lobbyist to research the bills and provide the ones that may impact the engineering community to the ACEC of VT Board for review. Based on information obtained from other ACEC state organizations, the cost for the lobbyist to provide this service appears to be at least \$17k with a more realistic cost around \$36k per year. Brian explained that this cost is not in ACEC of VT's budget and that we cannot currently afford this expense; therefore, the legislative committee is going to continue to track bills and notify the ACEC of VT Board when they find bills of concern.

#### Membership

- o ACEC of VT generates about \$26k in membership dues per year
- o The Board discussed the importance of increasing our membership
- o Brendan and Brian will prepare a summary of accomplishments and benefits provided by ACEC of VT to distribute to our existing and potential new members
- Brendan to provide a list our current member firms to the Board for review
